Student Ministry Cell Phone Policy

We know your students love technology, and we do too! We completely support the decision to allow your students to have their cell phones on this trip, because we are bringing our cell phone too! Cell phones are a great resource for communication and safety, as well as for fun. We also understand that it can be a distraction from the experience as well. The goal of this trip is to help students learn more about God as well as build friendships with other students on the same journey. This policy is simply to prevent cell phones from blocking that goal.

The following 3 guidelines are what we will put in place to help everyone have a great experience.

- Use during main sessions, small group time with leaders, prayer, etc. will not be permitted. Should this occur, a conversation with the student will happen, a second warning, then contact with the parents.
- Excessive use that disconnects your student from the event/other students will not be permitted. Should this occur, a conversation with the student will happen, a second warning, then contact with the parents.
- Inappropriate use of the device is grounds for immediate dismissal. This includes, but is not limited to, viewing/sharing inappropriate content and hurtful use toward others (bullying, gossip, slander, insults, etc.). Should this occur, parents will be immediately notified, the cell phone may be taken for the remainder of the trip, and students may be dismissed from the trip and asked to return home at their parents' expense.

Every family has different rules for use of cell phones. It is not our intent to counteract those rules. Rather, it is our goal to help your student have the best possible experience on this trip.
